Competitor Cross-Country Information

Cross-Country Reminders

Stop on Course: If the RED FLAG IS WAVED, you MUST STOP. The red flag will be used at Designated Stopping Points or at an obstacle, either because an obstacle you are approaching is blocked or in need of repair.

Please note the location of the Designated Stopping Points:

CCI5*-L: after 7, after 14c, after 21b and after 24cd

CCI4*-S: after 6b, after 11c and after 17c

Nine times out of ten, any stopping on course that is necessary will be done by the Stopping Stewards at these points. The Stopping Steward will begin taking time from the moment he/she waves the red flag signaling you to stop. A tall orange cone will be moved to the place where you were stopped so that you will have a marker as to where to re-start when the signal is given. In rare instances it may be necessary for a Fence Judge to stop competitors.

When you are given the signal to re-start, you need not do so from a standstill. You may start from behind the re-start line and be galloping by the time you cross the line, at which time the Stopping Steward or Fence Judge will start his/her watch to complete recording your hold time.

Grooms' Shuttle: Shuttles in the form of pickup trucks will travel to and from the Stable Area and the Start and Finish of Cross-Country beginning at 8:00 a.m. You may also utilize your rented golf carts if you have them.

End of Cross-Country Examination: Please note that all horses will be examined at the end of the Cross-Country Test. You MAY NOT LEAVE at the end of Cross-Country until your horse is released by the veterinary official.
