**RULES RE: COMPETITOR CONDUCT WHILE ON THE GROUNDS OF THE
KENTUCKY HORSE PARK
FOR THE LAND ROVER KENTUCKY THREE-DAY EVENT**

1. **PARKING IDENTIFICATION** – Exhibitors must display the appropriate Land Rover Kentucky Three-Day Event parking card or you will be denied access into the Kentucky Horse Park.
2. **PARK ADMISSION** – Exhibitors must be prepared to present, for each individual traveling in the vehicle, a Photo ID Badge.
3. **PARKING** – All parking must be within designated parking areas around the park.
4. **VEHICLES IN BARN AREA** – Vehicles are permitted in the barn areas for *unloading and loading only*. No parking allowed. Vehicles parked illegally in the barn aisles or on the ends of the barns will be towed.
5. **CAMPERS/RVS/HORSE TRAILERS W/LIVING SPACE** – Must go to Campground for water/electric hookup. **NO HOOKUP IS ALLOWED TO THE BARNES OR ANY WATER SPIGOTS OR ELECTRIC OUTLETS IN THE STABLING AREA OR VAN PARKING LOTS AT ANY TIME.** No exhibitors or grooms may sleep in the barns.
6. **DOGS** – Must be on a leash (not to exceed 6' in length) or suitably restrained in a tack stall, crate, etc. Animal(s) left in vehicles in distress can and will be removed from the vehicle and the grounds at the owner's expense.
7. **SPEED LIMITS** – All roads are 15 m.p.h. Barn areas and Campground 10 m.p.h.
8. **GOLF CARTS, MOPEDS, SCOOTERS, BICYCLES** – Will be allowed for 2021 ONLY but not on the cross-country course.
9. **ATVS** – 4-wheelers, 3-wheelers, dirt bikes (off-road-type motorcycles) are not permitted within the galloping lanes of cross country course.
10. **HORSES AND HORSE-DRAWN VEHICLES** – Have the right-of-way at all times in **ALL** areas.
11. **HALL OF CHAMPIONS ROAD** (across from Stable Office) – Closed to all event traffic including but not limited to, golf carts, mopeds and bicycles.

12. **PACKAGES/DELIVERIES** – Neither the Park nor EEI is responsible for any deliveries of any kind to an event or event participant. It is recommended that you send deliveries to a nearby UPS store or to your hotel.
13. **EXHIBITOR PROBLEMS AND SPECIAL REQUESTS** – *Must* be relayed to the Land Rover Kentucky Stable office, located by the domestic barn compound, to ensure prompt attention.
14. **DAMAGE TO AND/OR LOSS OF ANY PARK PROPERTY** – EEI is not responsible for damage to and/or loss of any Horse Park property by competitors. EEI will charge competitors for any damage done by them or their associates (grooms, owners, friends, family, etc.) to or loss of Horse Park property. Non-payment of the charges will be reported to the United States Equestrian Federation and no future entry from the competitor will be accepted for the Land Rover Kentucky Three-Day Event until the charges have been paid.
15. **ENFORCEMENT** – The Kentucky Horse Park Mounted Police division is charged with the enforcement of all traffic rules and regulations. Any and all necessary action taken by the Mounted Police are within the guidelines set by the Commonwealth of Kentucky to provide a safe environment for everyone to enjoy his/her particular activity at the Kentucky Horse Park.

Land Rover Kentucky organizer, Equestrian Events, Inc., contracts with private security during the competition and is supported by the Lexington Fayette Urban County Division of Police and the Kentucky State Police. All may enforce the traffic rules and regulations set by EEI for the Land Rover Kentucky Three-Day Event.
