A body temperature recording above 101.5° F before exercise or more than 2 hours after exercise is considered a fever that must be reported to a veterinarian and/or event management. Record in *Comments* the presence (Y) or absence (N) of clinical signs of disease, which includes, but are not limited to, the following: abnormal nasal discharge, coughing, diarrhea, ataxia or wobbly gait, altered mentation (aggression or stupor), abnormal slobbering or off feed.
